Date = race date
Track = race # and Race track
°CndVar = Temperature°C, track conditions and variance (seconds the track may be off of optimum performance as determined by ORC judge)
Class = Race Class

Purse = total prize money
 ¼ ½ ¾ = fastest quarters of the race (as established by the leader of the race at that time)
Fin = final time of the winning horse
Fld = # of horses in the race

PP = this horse's post position
 ¼ ½ ¾, **Str.** = horse's position at ¼, ½, ¾, Stretch of the race
Fin. = horse's final position
 L¾, L¼ = Horse's time for the last ¾ and final ¼ of the race.
Time = horse's final individual time

Odds = dollar odds (what the horse paid/would have paid to win)
Drv = Driver
Trn = Trainer

First, Second, Third = top 3 finishers of the race

WAGERING IS AS EASY AS 1-2-3

1. **Pick a horse...** any horse! Maybe you like its name or it has your lucky number
2. Decide where you think it will finish – 1st (Win), 2nd, 3rd
3. Go to any **mutuel teller** to make your bet—just say:
London, Race # _____; \$2 on horse # _____ to _____ (Win, Place or Show)

WIN = Your horse must finish 1st
PLACE = Your horse must come 1st or 2nd
SHOW = Your horse must come 1st, 2nd or 3rd

- Please exercise common courtesy. Wager as early as possible to avoid the last minute rush and the possibility of being shut out. No bets are accepted once the race has begun.
- The teller will collect your money and print out the ticket. Be sure to check your ticket!

EXOTIC BETS

The Daily Double

You must bet 2 horses that finish 1st in two (2) consecutive races.

Eg. Ask for “**\$2 DAILY DOUBLE 4 & 7**” if you want horse #4 to win in the first race and horse 7 to win the next.

Exactor

You must bet 2 horses that finish 1st and 2nd in the exact order in the same race.

Eg. Ask for “**\$2 EXACTOR 5 & 6**” if you want horse #5 to win and #6 to finish 2nd place.

Exactor Box

Pick 2 horses and they can finish 1st or 2nd.

Eg. Ask for “**\$1 *EXACTOR BOX 5 & 6**” = \$2 or “**\$2 EXACTOR BOX 5 & 6**” = \$4.

This gives you horse #5 to win with horse #6 finishing 2nd or horse #6 to win with horse #5 finishing 2nd.

*Note: Only 1/2 the total payout is received on the \$1 exactor box.

Triactor

Your 3 horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in the exact order, in the same race.

Eg. Ask for “**\$2 TRIACTOR 5,6,7.**” Horse #5 must win with horse #6 finishing 2nd and horse #7 finishing 3rd.

Triactor Box

Your 3 horses must finish 1st, 2nd or 3rd.

Eg. Ask for “**\$1 *TRIACTOR BOX 5,6,7**” = \$6 or “**\$2 TRIACTOR BOX 5,6,7**” = \$12.

This gives you 5,6 and 7 to finish 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any order.

*Note: Only 1/2 the total payout is received on the \$1 Triactor box.
